ON APPROVAL OF FORMS OF PERMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS FOR ISSUE OF PERMITS BY A LEGAL ENTITY OF PUBLIC LAW - NATIONAL FOOD AGENCY AND A LEGAL ENTITY OF PUBLIC LAW - REVENUES SERVICE

Article 1. In accordance with Article 40 of the Law of Georgia on License and Permits, Terms and Conditions and Regulations for Issue of Permits by a Legal Entity of Public Law – National Food Agency and a Legal Entity of Public Law – Revenues Service Be approved together with the attached Schedules.

Article 2. Decree N143 of the Government of Georgia as of 18 August 2005 on Terms and Conditions and Regulations for Issue of Permits by Competent Structures of Ministry of Agriculture of Georgia for the Transition Period Be deemed null and void immediately upon enactment of this Decree.

Article 3. This Decree Be effective from 1 January 2011.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS FOR ISSUE OF PERMITS BY A LEGAL ENTITY OF PUBLIC LAW - NATIONAL FOOD AGENCY AND A LEGAL ENTITY OF PUBLIC LAW - REVENUES SERVICE

Article 1. General Provisions

The present Regulations govern relations between the authorized administrative authorities and individuals and legal entities – seekers of permits for import and transit of products subject to veterinary control and import of vegetable products subject to phytosanitary control on the territory of Georgia during transition period.

Article 2. Interpretation of Terms

1. **Product subject to veterinary control** – any animals, products of animal origin and raw products of animal origin, fodder and food additives, biologic, medical and other chemical and pharmaceutical products used in veterinary.

2. **Plant products subject to phytosanitary control** – products, materials and objects subject to phytosanitary quarantine which can promote distribution of quarantine organisms.

3. **Fodder** – animal feed obtained industrially.

4. **Food Additives** are substances of natural and artificial origin added to fodder to enhance organoleptic features or prolong the shelf life thereof.

5. **Product of Animal Origin** – any food items and raw products obtained from dead animals: meat, meat products, industrially prepared sausages and preserves, offal, milk and dairy products, meat and poultry eggs, fish and fish products, honey and bee farming products.

Article 3. Types of Permitted Activities

Types of permitted activities are as follows:

a) Products subject to veterinary control during transit (This Permit is granted to facilities subject to the state veterinary control referred to in Schedule № 1);

b) Products subject to veterinary control during import (This Permit is granted to facilities subject to the state veterinary control referred to in Schedule № 2);

c) Vegetable products subject to phytosanitary control during import (This Permit is granted to facilities subject to the state phytosanitary control referred to in Schedule № 3).

Article 4. Permit Issuing Authority

Administrative authorities authorized to grant a permit for import and transit of products subjects veterinary control and import of vegetable products subject to phytosanitary control during import are by a Legal Entity of Public Law – National Food Agency (hereinafter the National Agency) and a Legal Entity of Public Law – Revenues Service (hereinafter the Revenues Service).

Article 5. Documents submitted to Obtain a Permit

1. Basic documents for obtaining a permit and the terms and conditions thereof are specified in the Law of Georgia on Licenses and Permits.

2. Application of seeker of permit for import of vegetable products subject to phytosanitary control shall provide for the name of exporting country and name, conveyance route, place of destination of imported products, and in case of stage-wise import – quantity and import period of each lot.

3. A document regarding type of products, quantity thereof, importing or transit country and conveyance route shall be attached to the application of the seeker of permit for import of vegetable products subject to phytosanitary control, and in case of biological and medical (pharmaceutical) products – Registration Certificate.

4. A permit for import of products subject to veterinary control is issued by a competent authority of the exporting country under the presented copy of Veterinary Health or Health Certificate corresponding to a sample approved under International codes for health of land and marine animals of WHO, if the product is originated:

a) in countries not specified in the List of suspect countries in terms of spread of dangerous infectious diseases, epidemics, epizooties approved by the Government of Georgia;

b) in the states – EU members, countries from European Economic Zone, united States of America, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Switzerland and Israel;

c) in establishments, the list of which, under satisfactory health warranties, is approved by a legal act of the European Commission (including the list of countries and products referred to on the EC web-site).

5. A permit for import of products subject to veterinary control from countries within the List of suspect countries in terms of spread of dangerous infectious diseases, epidemics, epizooties approved by the Government of Georgia (less cases laid down in subparagraphs “b” and “c” of Paragraph 4 of this Article) is issued under a copy of Veterinary Certificate or Health Certificate presented by a competent authority that corresponds to the sample approved under International codes for health of land and marine animals of WHO only by a person authorized by the Agency, according to the results of control exercised on the place of manufacturing thereof. If import from the said establishments of products subject to veterinary control is deemed reasonable, import from the said establishments may be performed within 6 months. In special cases (according to the risk-analysis results), if the National Agency considers it necessary to conduct additional inspection, import may be performed prior to expiry of the said period. Upon expiry of the said period, if the country is still within List of suspect countries in terms of spread of dangerous infectious diseases, epidemics, epizooties approved by the Government of Georgia, the permit for import may be granted under repeat control.

6. Transit of products subject to veterinary control through the territory of Georgia from the countries referred to in Paragraph 4 shall not require a permit and shall be performed only under the Veterinary Certificate or Health Certificate issued by a competent authority of the exporting country, and transit of products subject to veterinary control referred to in Chapter 01 (live Animals) defined in Commodity Nomenclature of Foreign

Economic Activity from countries within the List of suspect countries in terms of spread of dangerous infectious diseases, epidemics, epizooties approved by the Government of Georgia, the permit for import may be granted under repeat control (except for the cases laid down in Subparagraphs “b” and “c” of Paragraph 4 of this Article), shall be performed whether upon request of the seeker of permit or not, only upon the Veterinary Certificate or Health Certificate issued by a competent authority of the exporting corresponding to a sample approved under International codes for health of land and marine animals of WHO and under a written approval of a competent authority of the recipient country for the guaranteed acceptance of goods. *(Effective from 10 June 2013)]*

Article 6. Permit Issue Procedure

Permit issuing authorities make a decision on granting or waiver to issue permits in accordance with the Law of Georgia on Licenses and Permits.

Article 7. Procedure for Using Permit Forms and Accounting and Reporting

The procedure for using permit forms and accounting and reporting is governed by an individual administrative-legal act jointly developed by Revenues Service and National Agency.

Article 8. Effective Date and Effective Period of Permit

1. Permit for transit and import of products subject to veterinary control is issued for the period of one month.

2. Permit for import of vegetable products subject to phytosanitary control is issued for the period not exceeding six months.

Article 9. Control over Performance of Permit Terms and Conditions

Control over performance of permit terms and conditions is exercised in compliance with the Law of Georgia on Licenses and Permits.

Article 10. Liability for Violation of Permit Terms and Conditions. Revocation of Permit

Liability for violation of permit terms and conditions is charged in line with and the permit is revoked in accordance with the Law of Georgia on Licenses and Permits.

Article 11. Permit Register

Administrative authorities granting permit shall maintain Permit Register in compliance with Article 36 of the Law of Georgia on Licenses and Permits.
